Hair

If your child has long hair, can you please help them tie it up in a pony tail, bun or plait. This will:

- help reduce the risk of catching/spreading headlice
- keep cool in hot weather
- reduce the distraction of having hair over eyes at learning times

Swimming

As part of our school PE Programme, children will swim 3 or 4 times per week to get them confident and safe in the water. Sometimes there may also be a lunchtime swim. Please ensure your children bring togs and towel or a note if your child is sick or has a medical condition which means they cannot swim.

Enrolment Zone
