Symptoms of measles are:

- High temperature, sore eyes, runny nose
- Small white spots inside the mouth
- Tiredness, aches and pains
- Diarrhoea and/or vomiting is common
- A red blotchy rash

Chicken Pox

We have a large number of students with chicken pox at the moment. It is very contagious and children need to be kept at home until the blisters have dried up.

Symptoms of Chicken Pox are:

- Fever, aches and headache
- Spots appear and develop into blisters and are itchy
- Cough, sore throat and feeling sick are common
