Enrolment Zone

Enrolment at Insoll Ave School is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office. Our Board has determined that 10 places are likely to be available at New Entrant level for out of zone students next year

Applications for out of zone places are now being invited for those students who will become eligible for enrolment during 2020. If the number of out of zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. The deadline for receipt of applications for out of zone places is Friday 15 November 2019. An application is done by providing a letter to our office, stating the child's name, date of birth and address.



GLOBAL FLAVOURS

MALAYSIAN FRIED RICE



Ingredients:

- 2 eggs, beaten
- 1 tsp oil
- 1 c cooked rice
- 1 c mixed frozen veges
- 1/2 Tbsp soy sauce
- 1/2 Tbsp toasted sesame seeds (optional)
- 1 – 2 Tbsp spring onions, thinly sliced

Heat pan over medium heat, add oil. Pour in beaten eggs. As eggs cook, break them into smaller pieces using a fork. Add rice when the egg is partly (70 – 80%) cooked and stir. Add mixed veges and soy sauce and gently mix. Add sesame seeds and spring onions, gently toss to coat. Serves 2.
