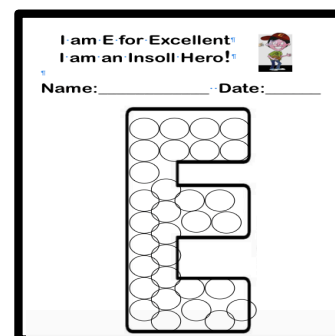

FRESH ASIAN STIR-FRY
