

## **Te Kōhao Health**

### **Te Kete Aronui – Literacy and Numeracy Programme**

Te Kōhao Health is excited again this year to offer Te Kete Aronui, a literacy and numeracy programme, to support tamariki to thrive in education.

Our programme will continue to provide a combination of both computer based and written learning activities in a small group environment. This year we will be including the younger age groups from year 1 to 8. This programme will continue to be run from the Enderley Community Centre on Tennyson Road, Enderley. For now they will be run on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays during school terms.

There will be two time slots for these days:

- 4-5pm for years 1 to 6 students
- 5-6pm for years 7 and 8 students

Note: this may change based on need.

Initial and ongoing assessments:

Each taura (student) will undertake a base line assessment to assess their level of learning and identify what support is needed. An individual learning plan will be developed collaboratively by Raima, each taura and his/her whānau. Periodically further assessments will be done to show how each taura is progressing. We will also be updating your tamaiti's kura of progress and receiving feedback from them. Once a taura has reached the level he/she needs to be they will be released back to kura hopefully with greater confidence to fully participate in the kura's curriculum.

Involvement and Expectations:

As parents/caregivers we encourage you to be involved. We will also keep you informed of progress and we encourage your feedback. We will also be encouraging your tamaiti's kura to provide feedback too.

The following is for you and your tamaiti to be aware of:

1. The cost is \$5 per child per session, please bring the right amount.
2. Please make sure your taura brings along a full drink bottle with them to each session.
3. From time to time homework will be given to complete. We encourage whānau to support their taura.
4. Each taura must arrive on time. If your taura is going to be away from a session you must notify me or Raima.

A light afternoon tea will be provided for taura during each session. Please note that this programme is not a Kip McGrath programme.

We look forward to working alongside you all and if you have any queries please contact Jonas or Raima.
