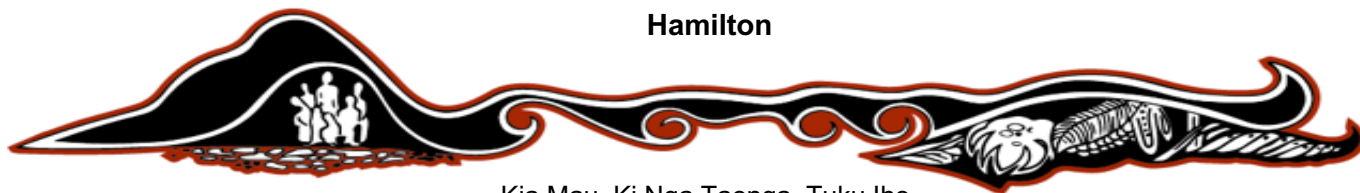

Dear Parents and Caregivers

Welcome - Nau mai haere mai
