Enrolment

The school serves the Enderley, Fairfield, and Fairview Downs areas.

The school has an enrolment zone and welcomes families from within its zone. The northern boundary is Snell Drive and the Wairere over bridge/Carrs Rd.

The southern boundary is at Five Cross Rds/Fifth Avenue.

The eastern boundary is Peachgrove Road.

On the west side of the school all of Fairview Downs is in-zone. Refer Map below.

New enrolments are required to live in the Insoll zone. These enrolments will require 'proof of residence' – a document such as a power bill, rental agreement...to verify residency.

For those outside of the Insoll zone – refer to website notice: *Enrolment Zone 2021*.

Hours of Opening

Staff are on site between the hours of 8.00am and 4.30pm.

Children attend classes from 8.45am to 2.30pm.

Lunchtime is 12.30 to 1.15pm

An After School Care Programme operates from 2.30 to 4.30 for working families who wish to enrol.

Māori Medium Education

There are language enrichment classes available at Years 4-6.

The school has no immersion/rumaki or bi-lingual classes.

All classes have lessons in basic te reo Māori and participate in weekly kapa haka lessons.

Fees

There are no set school fees.

The school Board of Trustees has joined the Ministry of Education '*No Donations Scheme*' which means the school receives funding to provide free activities, trips and camps.

Donations can still be made, if families wish to support the school

Stationery

For 2021 school year the Board of Trustees has undertaken to provide free, basic stationery for every child to start the school year. Parents may need to purchase any additional items later in the year if children use/fill all their books.

Swimming

Insoll Ave School has its own swimming pool. The pool is covered at night- which keeps the chill off the water temperature.

Swimming is a compulsory part of the Term 1 P.E. programme.

Children can also swim recreationally during lunch hours.

Uniform

The school has no compulsory uniform.

A green brimmed hat is required for the summer terms. The hat can be purchased at the school Office for \$13.00.

There is an optional red T. shirt (\$22.00) with the school logo, which is worn with black shorts or pants. These can be purchased from the school office.
