Covid Mask Update

The Ministry of Education are recommending the wearing of masks for children Years 4-6 for the start of Term 3. At this time the Ministry is saying this will be for the first 4 weeks of the term.

School will provide children with masks or they can use their own from home. This means there will be changes and we thank you for your support and understanding.

- Masks are to be worn at school for students at Year 4 to Year 6. Masks will be worn when indoors to reduce risk and promote health and safety.
- Indoor gatherings can be held with health protocols. This means each of our teams will be able to hold team assemblies and team events either outdoors or in the Hall (well ventilated).
- There will still be two break times to reduce the number of children in the playground at any
 one time, however playground areas where children can choose to play will be less
 designated and restricted.
- We ask that Parents/Whānau visit for essential reasons only and be masked when indoors.
 - The isolation period for positive cases and household contacts remains at 7 days.
